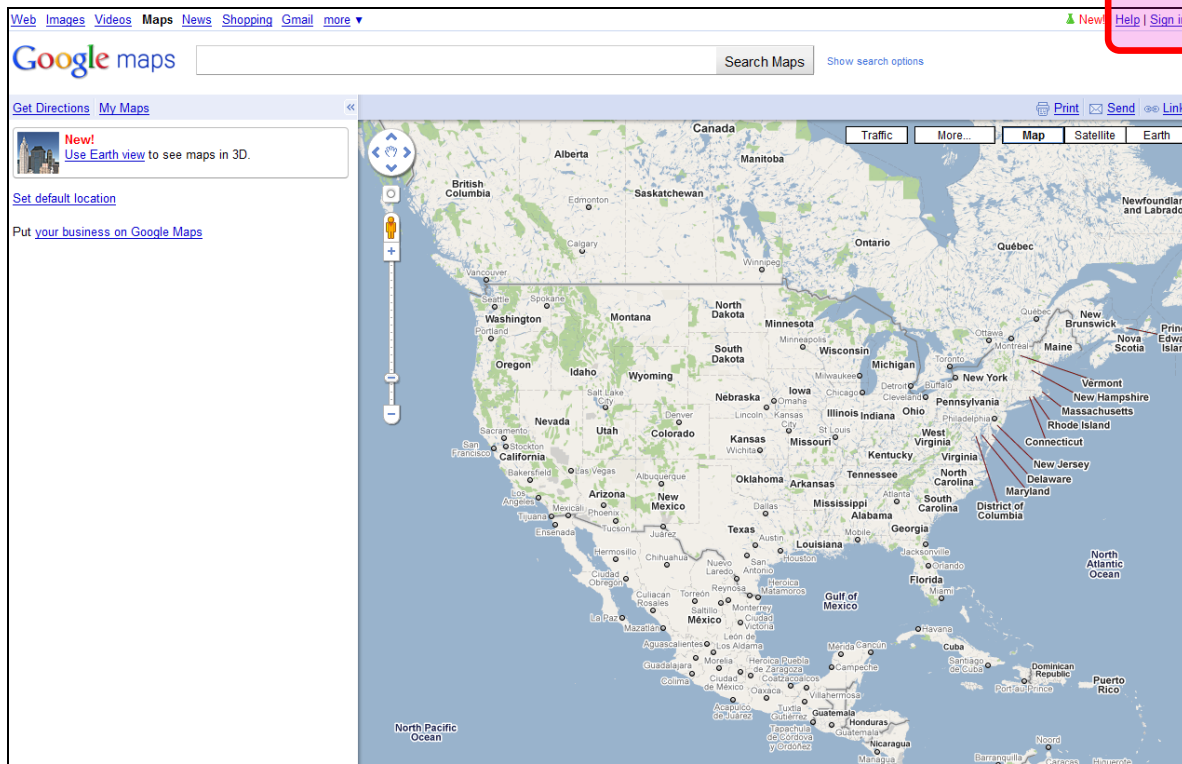
### Step 1: Go to Google...

First you will go to Google at [www.google.com](http://www.google.com)

Next, click on **Maps**.



You will see a page that looks like this (probably!). In the upper, righthand corner you'll **Sign in**

- Google Maps will automatically remember every address you enter
- You can access or remove these addresses at any time by clicking on the Saved Locations link

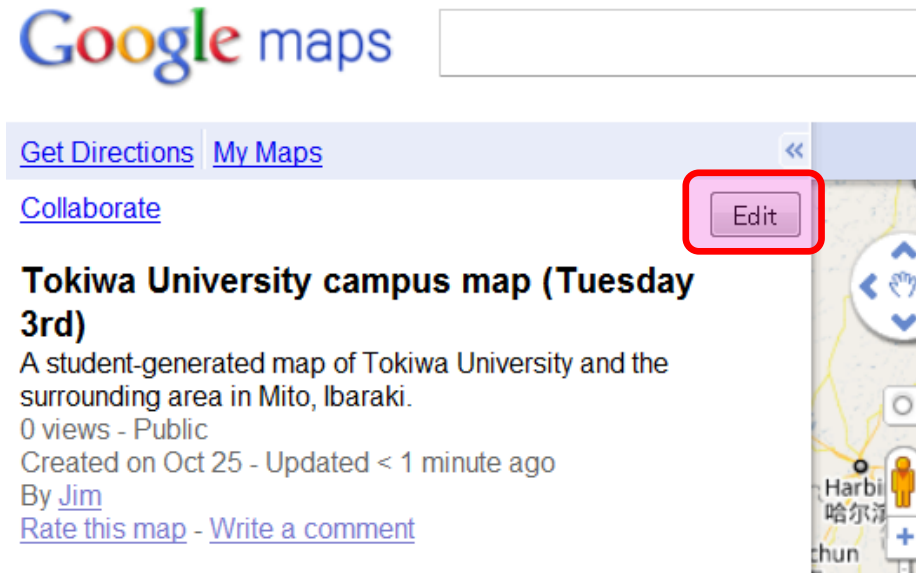

When you click the blue balloon, you'll can move the blue balloon to the correct place (yes, you can move it later).

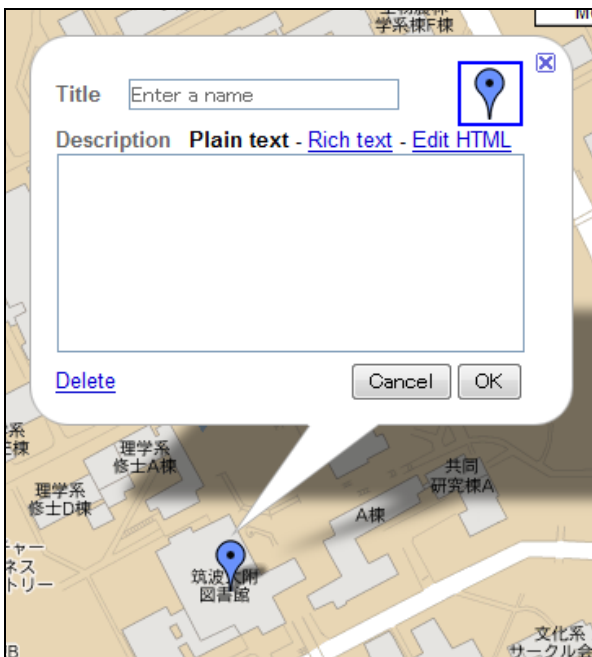

Then click the blue balloon and write your description!



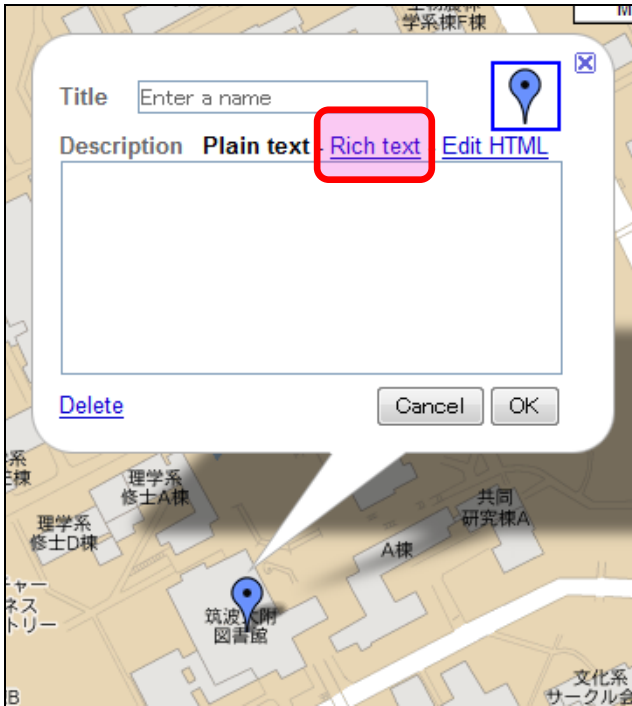
When you are finished, click **OK** and then **Save** or **Done**. If you want to add another balloon, then use **Save** and add another blue balloon.

## Step 2: Your Photo

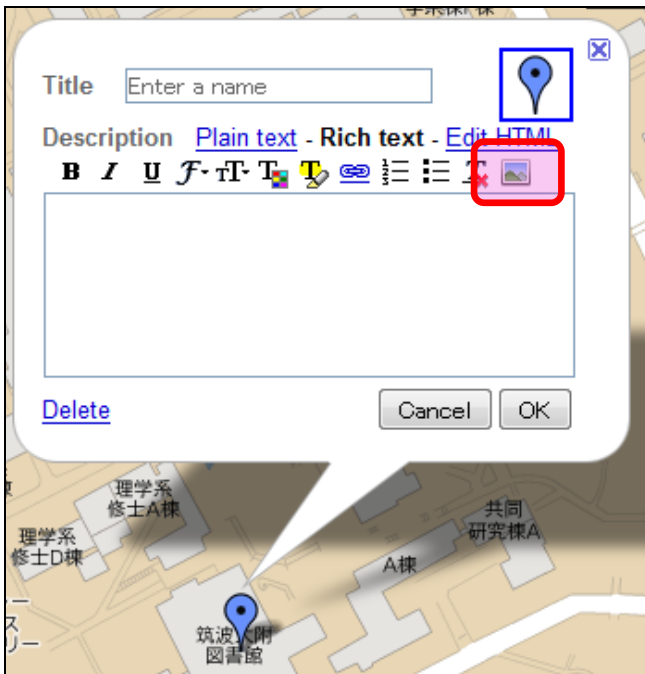
To add your photo, you'll need to again click Edit...

Then the Rich text link...



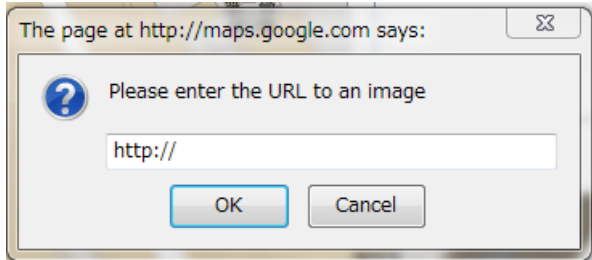
You'll see the photo icon here...

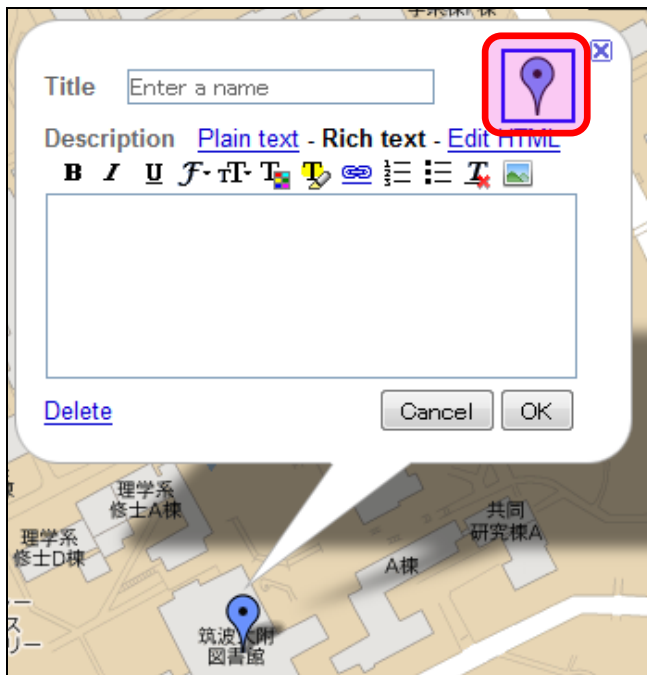


Just add the photo name in the empty place ☺
