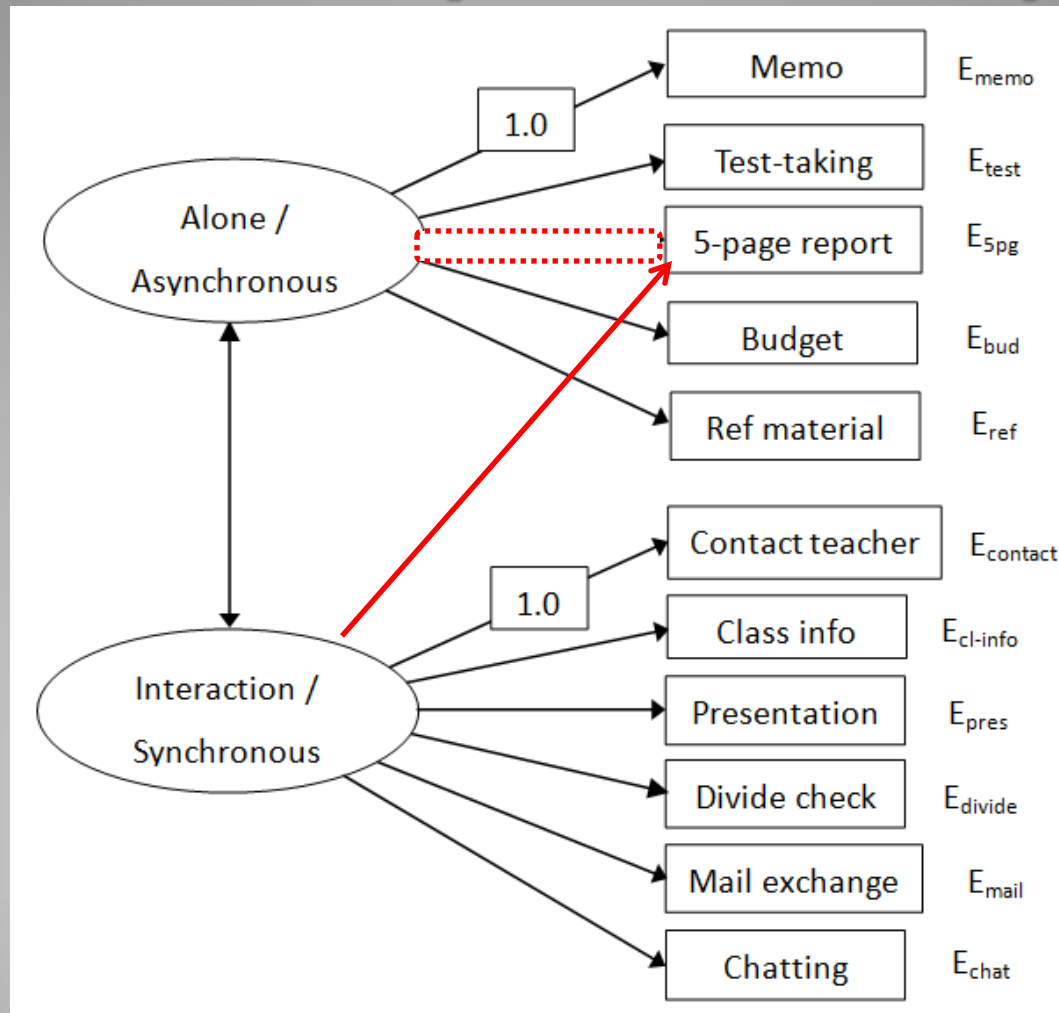
1. *Writing a memo*

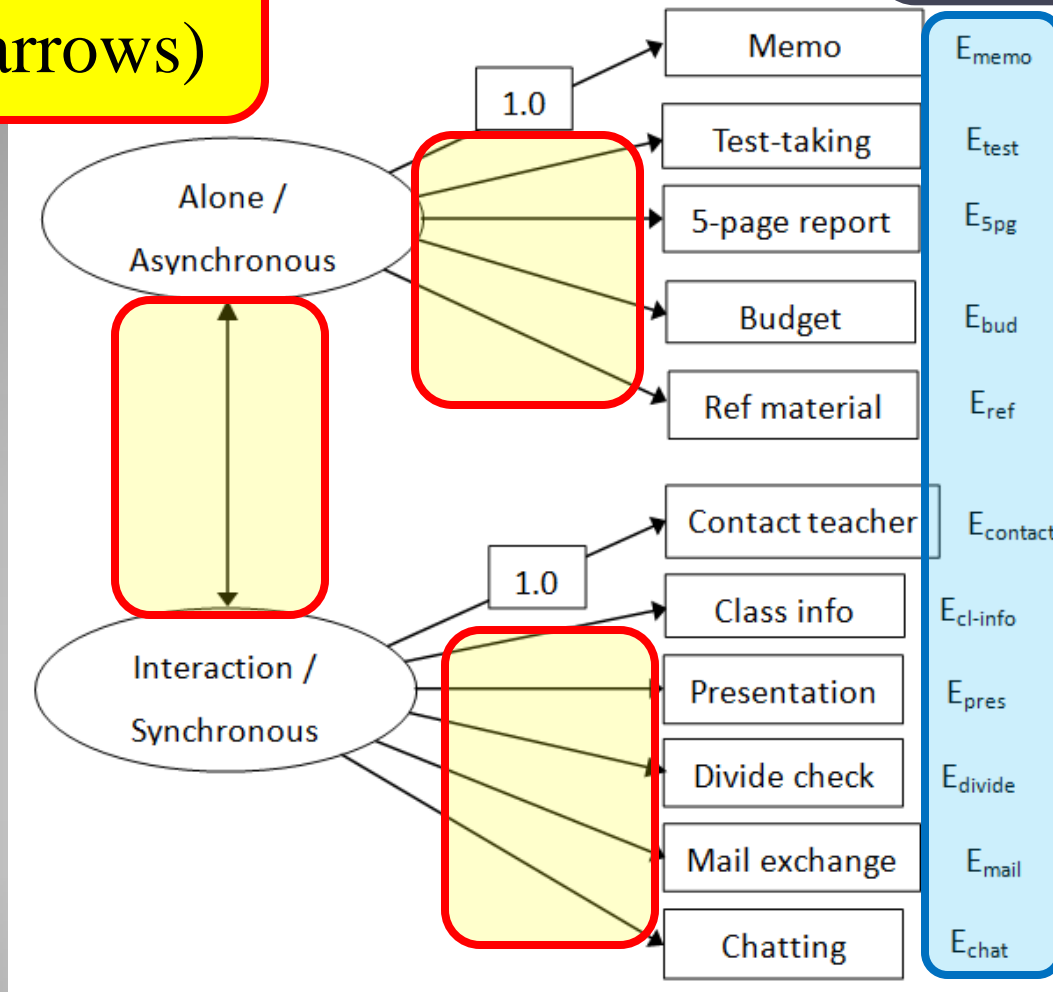

Experimental Factor A

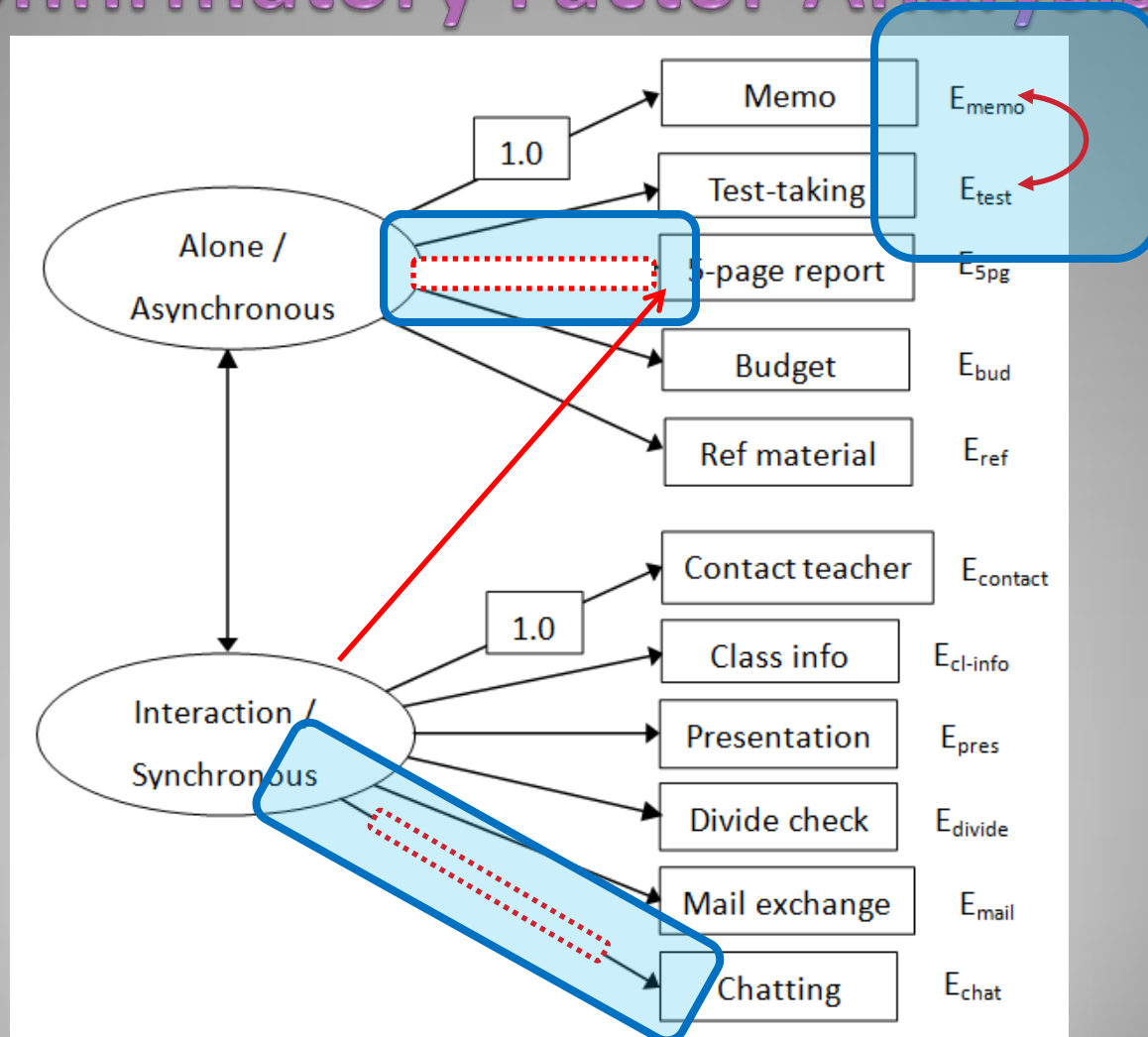
Mainly interested
