The WUT instrument is a series of questions asking about preference for using tech or using non-tech means for 11 tasks. Those 11 tasks are:



- 11. Chatting (F2F vs. Internet chat)


Confirmatory Factor Analysis




Mainly interested in paths (arrows)

Notice the error terms...


