


# Do you know three medalists from Meiji?

#### 'The greatest treasure of Japan', Jun Mizutani



Jun Mizutani graduated politics and economics in 2013. He was selected the most favorite athletes for Meiji students this year. Unfortunately, he announced his retirement due to eyesight problems after the Tokyo Olympics, however, he had joined the Olympics 4 times and won 4 medals in total. Additionally, he is the first player who won the medal in singles in Japan and the gold medal in mixed doubles in the world, so people call him 'The greatest treasure of Japan'.

## The next leader of Japanese table tennis, Koki Niwa



Koki Niwa also graduated in politics and economics in 2017. He joined the Olympics 3 times and won 2 medals in team competition with Mizutani. Additionally, his best world ranking is 5<sup>th</sup>, so Koki Niwa is expected as a new team leader. Also, he is known as a big fan of Nogizaka46 and made people surprised by leaving in the middle of a TV show to go to the concert.

## Prospective young baseball player, Masato Morishita



Masato Morishita also graduated in politics and economics last year. His high school baseball team could join Koshien when he was in the first grade, but he couldn't play in the game. However, he was selected as the member of U-18 and continued to play so well. In 2019, he entered Hiroshima Toyo Carp and at the Tokyo Olympics, he played as the first pitcher at the final round and led Samurai Japan to win the first prize.

who was one of the Meiji students and participated in the HAKONE EKIDEN, competed in the Barcelona Olympics as Japanese member of speed walking.


## Vaccine can be a Hero?

#### What is Happening in The World and Meiji Univ?

Since early 2020, COVID-19 has been disrupting the world. So far, about 218 million people have been

infected and 4.5 million have died. Students have been affected as well, and their lives have changed drastically from what they used to be. According to Meiji Univ, 523 students in total have been infected so far. The graph shows the monthly infections in the university.







## The Advantage of Vaccination

Because of the situation, students have no choice but to take online classes since 2020 in universities including Meiji Univ. So, they couldn't make friends, and have lost their college life. There is no need to be pessimistic about vaccines, however. It was confirmed by clinical study that vaccines create immunity against COVID-19.

#### How does the Vaccine Affect Students?

The vaccination program started in Japan on February 17, and about 70 million people in Japan have now completed at least one shot. Some students have also completed it, and it is expected to increase in the future. At Meiji, vaccinations started on September 1. Therefore, we conducted a questionnaire to the students to find out their vaccination status. First of all, Figure 1 shows that 52 students have already been vaccinated, 32 haven't. Looking at F2, Pfizer and Moderna were used. Next, side effects (F3). Among the 54 vaccinated student's respondents, only 4 had no side effects at all, indicating that most of them had some symptoms. Among them, many felt pain in their arms or fever. The symptoms lasted a day or two (F4). The awareness survey showed many people think they should be vaccinated regardless of whether they have taken it yet(F5).





# Don't Forget!


There have been some deaths among those who have been vaccinated, which may cause some people to feel uneasy. It is also true that many people have side effects. We have the right to choose whether to take the vaccine or not. But we must remember that we should avoid infection regardless of vaccination.


# Working Problem under the Pandemic

Most countries including Japan are in the pandemic. We have been forced to avoid contact with people since early in 2020. The Pandemic affects student part-time jobs. In Japan, the average income of student parents has been steadily declining for decades. Many students do part-time jobs for their living.


#### Working Problems in Meiji Student's Part Time Jobs

We conducted the survey research for students who take the summer intensive courses. 77% of students currently have part-time jobs. In Meiji, many of the workplaces where students work are educational (34.7%) and restaurants (20.4%). Second, we ask about the impact on your part time job under the pandemic. 20% of students answered, "it's hard to get a new part time job." and 18% of them answered" shift is reduced. = income has reduced". These results are less than we expected, however, we can say that it gets difficult to get new jobs and earn enough money under the pandemic. Our final question is about the impact on life due to not being able to make enough money. Unexpectedly, 63% of students answered that there are no particular problems and 22% of students answered "not going or reducing going out with friends. It seems that few students worked in a workplace that was greatly influenced by the pandemic. See also. 




Negative impact on part time job under the pandemic




## Negative impact on life due to not being able to make enough money

# EXPECT A NEW PRIME MINISTER


#### There is no doubt that Japanese Prime Minister will be replaced

#### **Become a Prime Minister of Japan**

In Japan, the Prime Minister must be a member of the Diet. After the election, the Prime Minister is designated by two houses. Most prime ministers are the leader of the majority party in the house of representatives. The Prime Minister has no term limit. However, there is a term limit for the leader of each party. A person must win the election in the majority party to become the Prime Minister of Japan.

# The movement of voting rate per each age group when it comes to the snap election of the House of representative




## Viewing the young's voting-rate

#### What is Uber Eats?


Uber Eats is a food delivery service. Now the number of Uber users is increasing more because of the pandemic. In the same way, the number of Uber Eats drivers is also increasing. Uber changed their work style, because at Uber, Meiji students can work anytime.

#### **Students'** salary

#### decreases

The left graph shows that 34.9% of people say, "My salary decreased." Then, people started to work for food delivery services. Especially, they work as Uber Eats drivers.

If they become an Uber Eats driver, they can work regardless of time! Also, the right graph shows half of people have used delivery services. Maybe students can earn lots of money between their classes.



#### Very easy to start

## delivering

It's easy to become an "Uber Eats driver." Simply, sign up and buy a rucksack. First, you have to download the application "Uber Driver" and sign up. Send the

photos of required information; a profile photo and some identification cards. It takes about two weeks to get it approved. While you wait for the approval, you should buy the rucksack for delivery on Amazon. It costs 4,000 yen.

#### Earn over 2000 yen an hour

Uber Eats drivers will be able to earn money efficiently.

The fee for delivery is calculated by basic cost, promotion and tips. The basic cost doesn't change. However, promotions change by areas, time and distance. For example, from 100 to 200 yen is added to the delivery fee as promotions in case of rainy days or in popular areas. If you deliver in the orange area of the picture, you can receive a promotion for each delivery. That's why students who want money and want to work flexibly should start delivery.


#### Melotozzo
