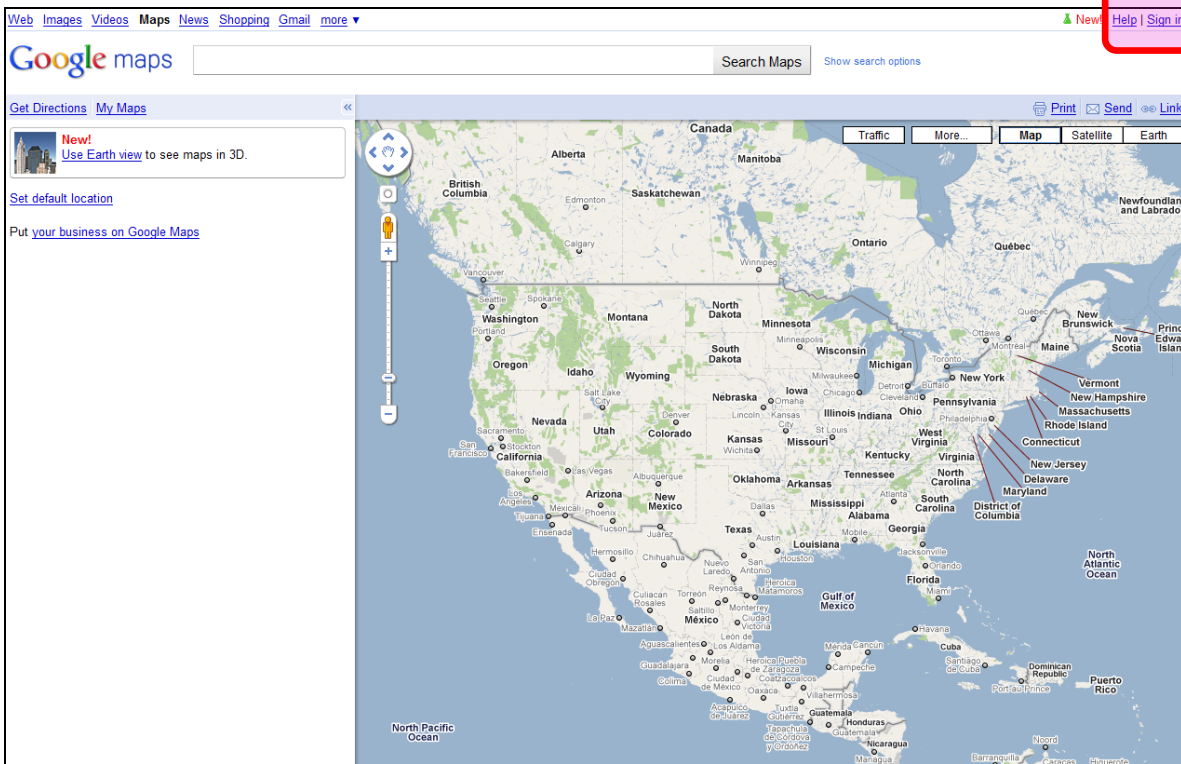
### Step 1: Go to Google...

First you will go to Google at [www.google.com](http://www.google.com)

Next, click on **Maps**.



You will see a page that looks like this (probably!). In the upper, righthand corner you'll **Sign in**



Yes, click that link and you'll see...



Next you'll log in (wow). We will use Gmail account to edit our class map.


Login name: tgaku.student.##

I will give you an account number (##). Everyone has the same password; please do NOT change the password. (If you have a gmail account, you may use that, but please tell me so I can invite you to our class map.)

Now you'll see this page. Click **My Maps** ...

...and you'll see this...

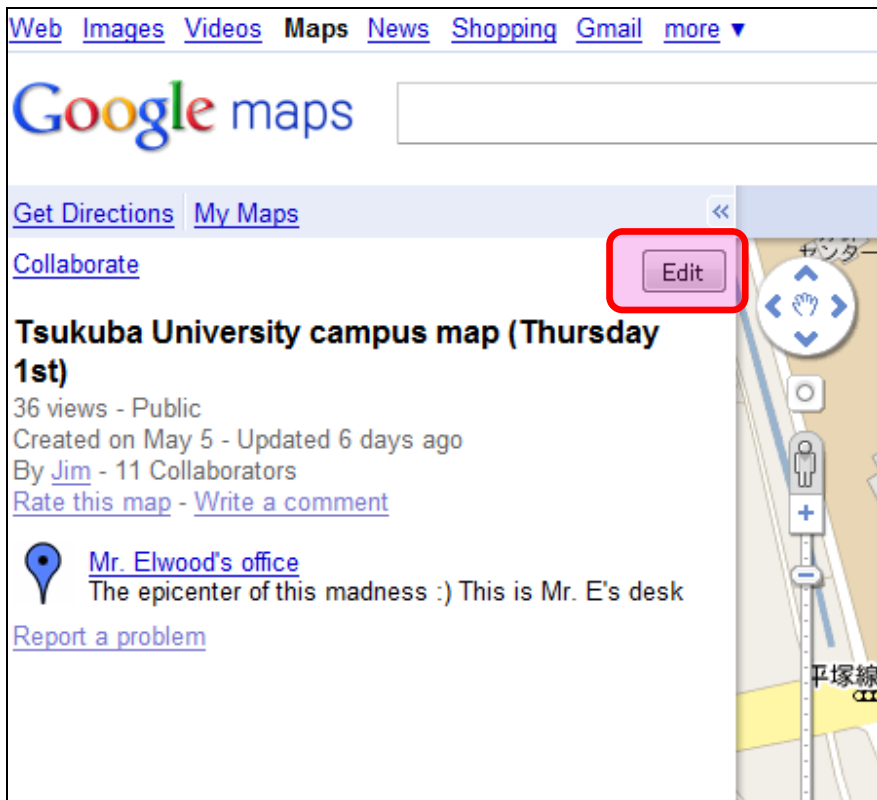

...to arrive here. To add your place, you'll click the **blue balloon**...



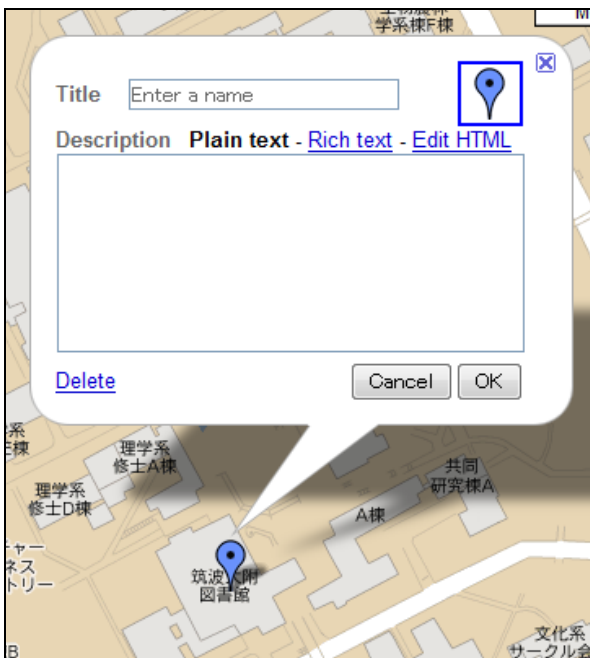

Then click the blue balloon and write your description!

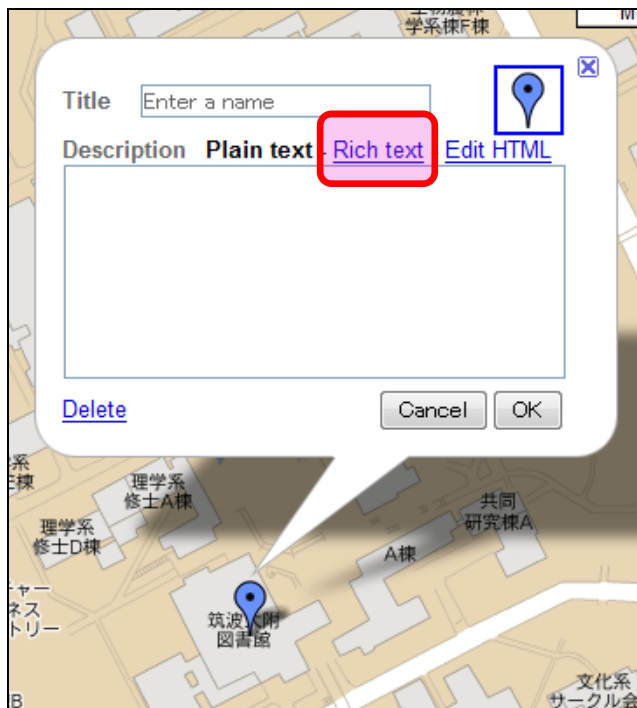


When you are finished, click **OK** and then **Save** or **Done**. If you want to add another balloon, then use **Save** and add another blue balloon.

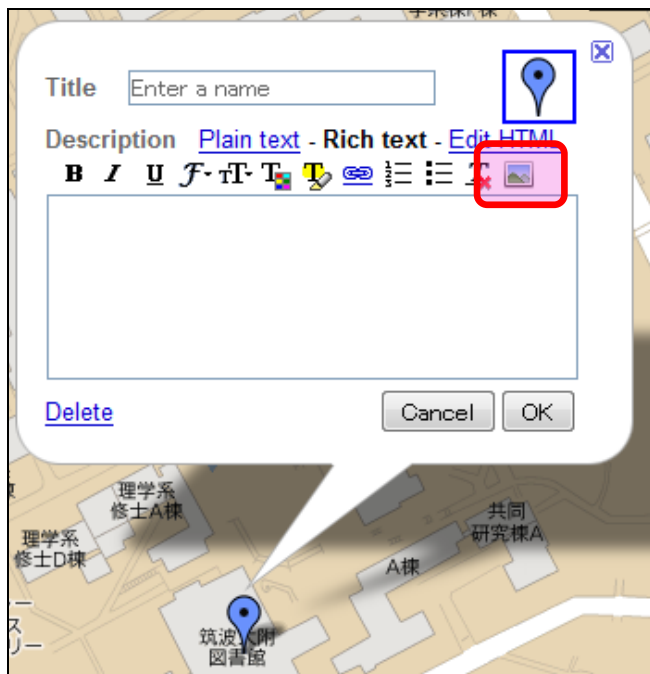
### Step 2: Your Photo

Then the Rich text link...



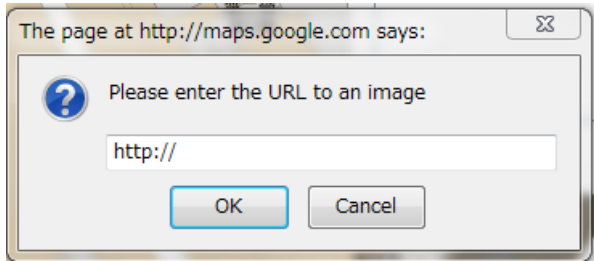
You'll see the photo icon here...

2. Next, you'll add the path to your photo in this box...

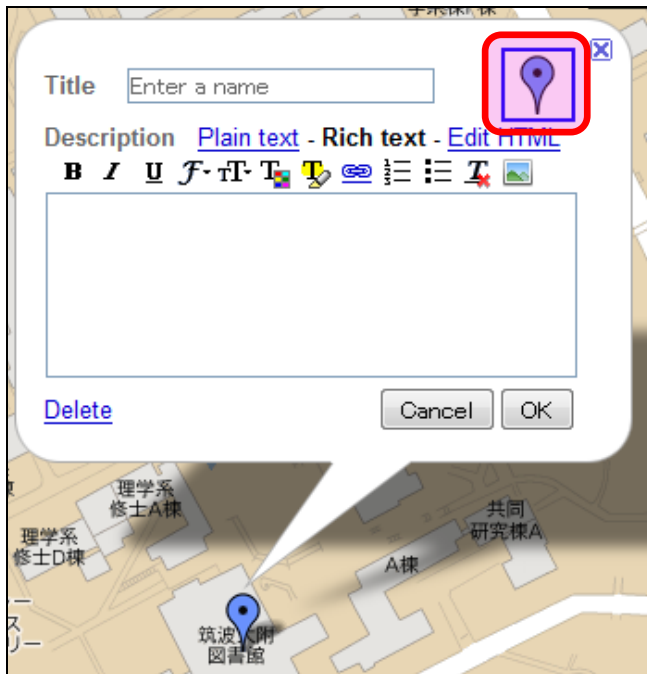


Just add the photo name in the empty place ☺
