


hypothesis

- Most students have the opinion which developed countries should make effort.


Q1: Do you save electric power?




Q2 :How many ways do you know about saving power?




Q3: Choose one which line in descending order about power consumption.




Q4:Do you think that saving power is effective in preventing global warming?






Q6: Do you think deforestation is related to global warming?




