Feel free to use a journal in which one of our class readings appeared (e.g., Lee, 1995, in *Foreign Language Annals*) or any other TESOL/SLA/EFL journal that you find or are familiar with (I've included a list below, but there are certainly many more). Please contact me with any questions.

This review consists of the following parts:

1. Bibliographical information about the journal (where accessible, published since when, publisher). An image of the journal cover would also be a nice touch (hint, hint).
2. The journal's mission statement (sure, go ahead and copy-paste this, but adding a comment or two would be appropriate).
3. A summary of the types of articles published in the journal (with commentary, of course).
4. Bibliographical information about at least one article that you think looks interesting; you don't need to actually read this for me or for our class, but you might add it to your many 'free-time' articles that you'll get around to reading in the future.
5. Deadline: December 15, but feel free to complete it earlier.
6. Submission: This is to be included in your reaction journal (for many of you, that would be your blog).
